DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church says even our scars can be beautiful?

A popular saying among sports enthusiasts is, "no scar, no proof." Where there is no credibility to your story unless you have the scars to back up your extraordinary claim. This unwillingness to believe something unless we have visible confirmation, isn't a new concept; even our risen Lord had His doubters. As we continue through the Easter season, it's good to remember that the Cross and the Resurrection of Jesus are not two separate stories, they're one great mystery. Jesus could not rise without first dying. So, it follows that His death would have no meaning without His Resurrection. As St. Paul says, "If Christ has not been raised, your faith is in vain" (1 Cor 15:14). The saints remind us how astonishing this mystery really is. It's not surprising that a man should die, but that God should die for us is beyond understanding. And just as amazing is the truth that Jesus rose from the dead. Only God could accomplish something so extraordinary. One of the most beautiful details of the Resurrection is that Jesus kept His 5 wounds: one in each hand and foot, and one where the spear was thrust into His side. But why keep any at all? In a world where we need to "see it to believe it", God greets man with signs of hope that proves His love for us and heals our brokenness. When He appeared to Thomas, He invited him to touch those wounds, and Thomas could only respond, "My Lord and my God!" (Jn 20:28). These glorious wounds show us what Christ's love looks like: victorious, self-giving, and forever offered to the Father. Because we share in Christ's life, we're also invited to share in His Cross. St. Paul says, "God forbid that I should glory except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ!" (Gal 6:14). If we want to share in the joy of the Resurrection, we must love as Jesus loved; fully, generously, and sacrificially. That's the "new commandment" He gave us: "Love one another as I have loved you" (Jn 13:34). The first gift of the risen Christ was the Holy Spirit (Jn 20:22), the Spirit of love. Through this gift, we are not only able to know God, we are invited to share in His very life. The saints call this "divinization": becoming more and more like God through grace. Christ's wounds remind us that love is not a one-time "yes," but a continual offering of ourselves to God and to one another. And His risen wounds proclaim the victory of that love, a victory He wants to share with each of us right now. So, don't be afraid to follow Jesus in your current state of brokenness. Don't hide your wounds from God. Jesus doesn't call us because we're perfect, He calls us because despite our scars, we're still beautiful in His eyes. May the glorious wounds of Christ draw us deeper into His love, His sacrifice, and His joyful Resurrection. Want to draw closer to God this Easter? Confession is a great place to start. Stay tuned next week when we take a closer look at God's divine mercy.

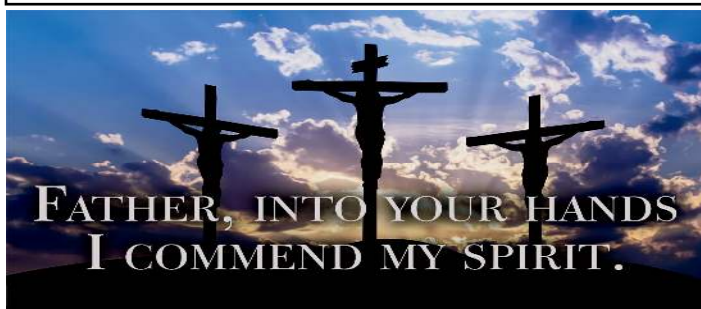
