



Anyone in need of Home Visits, Confession, Communion, etc. (Homebound Services) due to illness, disability, and/or age, please call the Parish Office at 830-569-3356 to add them to the list of parishioners that are served by this ministry.

The Archdiocesan Parish Ministry Formation program is coming back to St. Andrew's this fall. This program provides comprehensive pastoral formation for those who currently serve or seek to be involved in ministries and services in the Church, such as Catechists, Liturgical Ministers, Youth Ministry, Family Life ministers, etc. Upon completion of the program, Archbishop Gustavo Garcia-Siller will preside over the Commissioning Mass. These courses seek to ensure that parish ministers have a foundational knowledge and understanding of the teachings of the Catholic Church. If you are interested in learning more on the ministry God has called you to and receive certification in that ministry, consider signing up for this amazing program. The cost of the program is \$25.00 per course. Dates and courses are posted on the bulletin board in the Narthex. Pre-registration for next year's Religious Education, 2025-2026, opens on our last day for this

school year, April 27, 2025.

Anyone interested in the OCIA – Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, be that adult baptism, becoming a Catholic, baptized Catholics continuing their conversion in receiving their initiating sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation. Your journey begins **now** for next year's Easter Vigil, 2026. Per the Archdiocese of San Antonio, the duration of this process will be at least one year from Easter Season to the Easter Vigil each year. Contact Debbie Shows, DRE, for more information.
