DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know that the Church says, even legally divorced Catholics can receive the sacraments of Confession and Holy Communion?

So, before we make a blanket rule to cover all situations, it's important to know that each person's story is unique and you should contact your local parish priest if you are uncertain about yours. For starters, divorce is not always a sin, especially if the divorce is no fault of your own, but in instances where it is a sin, absolution for the truly repentant person, coupled with a firm commitment to not sin again, can be attained through confession. Since divorce only dissolves the civil union (the paper contract), the sacramental part of the marriage (the covenant with God), is still presumed valid until otherwise declared annulled, if ever. So, if the divorced person remains single and sexually abstinent (waiting until remarriage after receiving an annulment), a good confession, in most cases, is all that is needed to reopen the avenue to receiving the precious Body and Blood of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. We all make mistakes in life, but none should keep us from the love Jesus so desperately wants to share with us. So, if it's been a while since you have partaken of Holy Communion because someone told you that your divorce disqualified you, Jesus Himself is ready to welcome you back home. Please contact your local parish office to schedule your confession time or for more details. Tune in next week for part three on marriage and divorce. Where we'll tackle what to do if you're already remarried but never got an annulment.

Are you ready to baptize your child 6 and under?

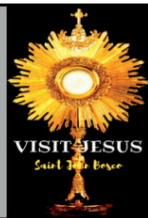

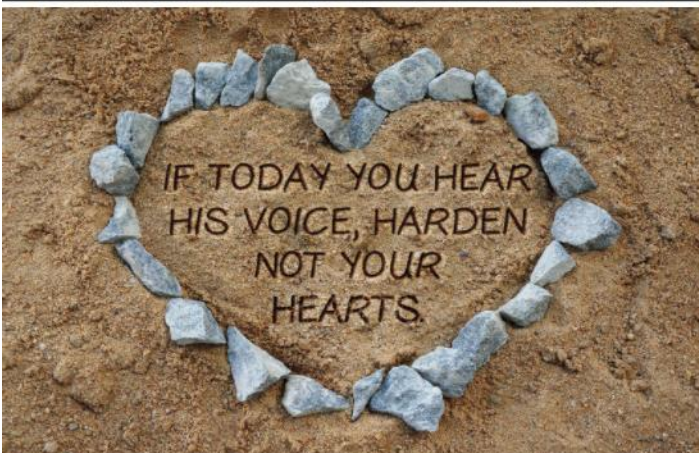
Getting Married?
