A Clever Woman of Faith

Why is Jesus being so difficult with the Canaanite woman? At first he seems to be putting her off. He does this not to discourage her, but to draw a response of faith. He wants to see how persistent she is in her request.

We can tell ourselves that we are people of faith, but how easily are we discouraged? Do we think God has forgotten us when we experience trouble? The woman's clever reply to Jesus reminds us that she trusted in Jesus' power and willingness to help. She refused to give up and stop asking.

Jesus was also teaching his disciples that faith is more important than nationality. Long after Jesus' resurrection, the church struggled with the question of non-Jewish believers. Today, we may be doing the same thing in reverse. Some people think that only Catholics can be saved and that there is no hope for Protestants, much less for Jews. But though some rejected Jesus, God never rejected the Jews.

Finally, Jesus responded to her persistence. He shows us that we can keep praying till we get an answer to our prayer. The more time we spend in prayer, the more likely we are to listen to God's answer. Prayer can help us come to the peaceful acceptance that God only does what is best for us.

The Archdiocese of San Antonio is unconditionally committed to the protection of children, youth, and vulnerable populations within our community. To ensure their protection from harm, it is mandatory that all adults who minister to children, youth, and vulnerable adults must receive Safe Environment Training every three years. The following are the three modules and those that are required to take each training:

Safe Environment Training

Per the Code of Conduct, the Archdiocese of San Antonio requires a background check (renewed every three years) and three trainings:

Sexual Harassment Training:

Required for clergy, candidates for ordination, employees, and all adult volunteers. Must be renewed every three years.

Protecting God's Children:

Required for clergy, candidates for ordination, employees, and adult volunteers who minister to children/youth. Ministries included: Catechists, Catechist aides, Religious Education support volunteers, and all Liturgical Ministers. Must be renewed every three years.

Vulnerable Adults Training:

Required for clergy, candidates for ordination, employees, and adult volunteers who minister to adult vulnerable populations. Vulnerable adults are those 18 and older to whom you are ministering. Ministries included: All Liturgical Ministers (including homebound ministry), Knights of Columbus, Guadalupanas/os, St. Vincent de Paul, and ACTS., Must be renewed every three years.

The Archdiocese of San Antonio is currently using Virtus. To complete the training, go to VirtusOnline.org to update your record. If you are new to Virtus, go to VirtusOnline.org and register as a first-time user. Note the criteria above to determine the training modules you will receive. Modules **MUST** be completed within 30 days from August 13. Religious Education Catechists and support volunteers MUST comply before ministering to children, teens, or adults enrolled in Religious Education. There are NO EXCEPTIONS to these guidelines. Please contact Debbie Shows, our Safe Environment Coordinator, for any questions or concerns. Together, we will continue to make St. Andrew and Sacred Heart a safe a nurturing place for ALL of God's people.
