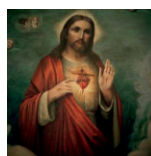

DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church says the Sacrament of Confirmation is more than an indicator that you're ready for marriage?

While the Sacrament of Confirmation itself has nothing to do with marriage or age, at least in the physical sense, Confirmation does bring about a spiritual maturity within the recipient's relationship with the Persons of the Holy Trinity, that often marks them ready to take on new life challenges. Since we typically experience some of these new challenges after childhood, like leaving for college or getting married, it's easy to relate the sacrament with a rite of passage. However, the sacrament brings about a much more powerful change; confirmation deepens our baptismal life that calls us to be missionary witnesses of Jesus Christ in our families, neighborhoods, society, and the world. We receive the message of faith in deeper and more intensive manner with great emphasis given to the person of Jesus Christ, who asked the Father to give the Holy Spirit to the Church for building up the community in loving service. Confirmation not only fully initiates us into the Body of Christ (the Church), but it also allows us to wholeheartedly claim God as our Father; to call to Him with confidence, trusting He hears our cry. "All who are guided by the Spirit of God are sons of God; for what you received was not the spirit of slavery to bring you back into fear; you received the Spirit of adoption, enabling us to cry out, 'Abba, Father!' The Spirit himself joins with our spirit to bear witness that we are children of God." (Romans 8:14-16) And so, if we are indeed His children, we are also co-heirs to His promises. Are you ready to confirm your appointment? Please contact your local parish office. Next week we'll discuss the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit.

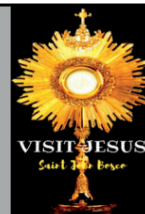

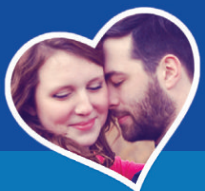
