DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church says not all gifts come with bows on top?

According to the tradition of the Catholic Church the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are known as wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of God. St. Thomas Aquinas states that these gifts are heroic character traits that Jesus Christ alone possesses in their entirety, but that he freely shares with the members of his mystical body, the Church. These gifts are showered on every baptized Christian as a permanent endowment at their baptism and later sealed in the sacrament of confirmation. Also known as the sanctifying gifts of the Spirit, they help the recipient become more open to the promptings of the Holy Spirit in their lives, helping them to grow in holiness and preparing them for heaven. They help us to go beyond the limits of our human nature and capacity to reason, allowing us to participate in the supernatural life of God. Necessary for man's salvation, which he cannot achieve on his own, they serve to "perfect" the four cardinal or moral virtues (prudence, justice, fortitude, and temperance) and the three theological virtues (faith, hope, and charity). These gifts lie in wait, until the baptized person is so moved to act upon them, through the promptings of the Holy Spirit. For instance, one may be nudged to use the gift of Fortitude particularly when a difficult or dangerous situation arises, like when facing a life-threatening medical diagnosis. While the easy thing may be to give up on life and drown in self-pity, Fortitude brings about the courage needed to boldly face the illness head on. Knowing that no matter the outcome, you can rejoice by virtue of the assurance of everlasting life, promised by Jesus to those who believe. So, if you're looking to gain some Wisdom on how to unwrap the other gifts of the Holy Spirit, please contact your local parish office for details. Stay tuned next week as we take a closer look at the difference between being Christian and being Catholic.

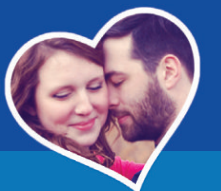
