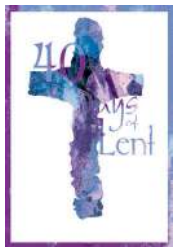

DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church says God did not give us the Bible?

Now hold on, before you call the Archbishop, let me say that all the teachings in the Bible, absolutely come from God. But the Bible, as we know it today, wasn't written down by God. Afterall, Jesus did not spend His time on earth writing. The only time we hear of Jesus writing anything is when He writes on the ground with His finger (John 8:3-9). The fact that we don't have any writings from Jesus, or that He didn't handwrite the Bible is not a problem for Catholics. While the Bible is essential, it is not the only means of transmitting the Faith. For this, Jesus established His Church, which St. Paul calls "the pillar and bulwark of the truth" (1 Tim 3:15). This is why Jesus trained His disciples to be the primary method of transmission. The books of the Old Testament were written long before Jesus was born, and the New Testament books were all completed at the end of the first century A.D. But the Bible wasn't officially gathered into a single, recognized collection until the late 4th century, about 300 years after Jesus was crucified. The Catholic Church, guided by the Holy Spirit, ultimately determined which books belonged in the biblical canon. Many of the writings that would eventually be included were already being read at Mass and preached about from the earliest days of the Church. In fact, there were many early Christian texts circulating at the time, far more than the 27 books that would ultimately make up the New Testament. Church leaders had to carefully discern which writings were truly inspired by God and connected to the apostles, and which ones only claimed to be. This process eventually came to a head in 382 at the Council of Rome, convened under Pope Damasus, where the Church officially listed the 73 books of Scripture. That same canon was confirmed again at the Councils of Hippo (393) and Carthage (397) and later reaffirmed by the ecumenical Council of Florence in 1442. Finally, in 1546, the Council of Trent definitively declared this same canon once more; especially important because it was being challenged at the time by early Protestant reformers, including Martin Luther. Martin Luther had difficulty proving his stance on things like refuting scriptural evidence for purgatory and upholding the protestant teaching of salvation through faith alone. In his search for truth, he eventually discarded four books from the original 73 and left it up to individual interpretation on which books others would like to add or remove. Hence, the Bible used by the early Christians for more than 1000 years preceding the Reformation (before 1517), is not the same Bible found in Protestant denominations today. After much opinionated debate, they finally settled on a 66-book version, like the King James edition. So, what happened to the original Bible that contains the 73 books given to us by the Church that Jesus Christ started in 33 A.D.? It's still in use daily inside the Catholic Church, unchanged since the 4th century. If you are interested in uncovering more historical truths of the Catholic Church, your local parish is a good place to start digging. Stay tuned next week when we dive into the question, why are you Catholic?

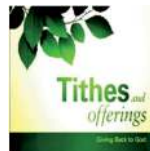

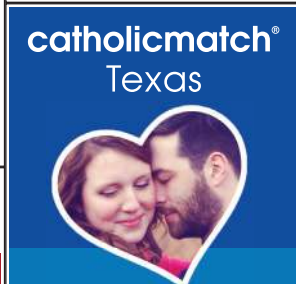
