You may drop off donations in the receptacles in the Church, the St. Vincent de Paul Building, or the Parish Office. Please check for expiration dates on donated food items.

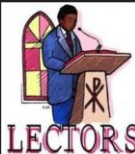

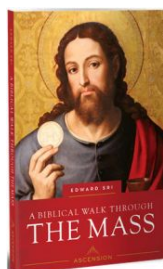
