DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church faith is a gift that grows when you give it away?

Faith is one of the greatest gifts God gives to His people. But when we receive it, we aren't meant to keep it to ourselves. The Catholic Church is a family of believers who support one another in faith, worship, and service. Through the encouragement of fellow Christians, we find strength to persevere and grow in holiness. Faith often grows not through extraordinary events but through daily acts of prayer, kindness, forgiveness, and love. Yet the Church teaches that trials can strengthen faith when we place our trust in God. Like gold refined by fire, faith becomes purer and stronger through perseverance. Faith is not simply a human opinion, a feeling, or a conclusion reached through reason alone. Faith is a supernatural gift from God, infused into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, inviting us into a living relationship with Him. At the same time, faith requires our free response, a willing act of trust in the God who reveals Himself to us. "Faith is to believe what you do not see; the reward of this faith is to see what you believe." (St. Augustine) Just like the centurion who believed Jesus only had to say the word and his servant would be healed, our faith in Jesus is at work even when we can't see it yet. It teaches us to trust that God is present, guiding every step and working all things for our good. Like a seed planted in fertile soil, faith is meant to grow. The Catechism reminds us that to live, grow, and persevere in faith, we must continually nourish it with God's Word and ask the Lord to increase it. Faith is not static; it is a lifelong journey.

One of the most important ways to strengthen faith is through prayer. Prayer opens our hearts to God's grace and allows us to deepen our friendship with Him. We learn to recognize His voice, trust His guidance, and rest in His love. St. Padre Pio encouraged believers with these simple words, "Pray, hope, and don't worry." When faith is accompanied by prayer, fear begins to lose its power, and hope takes root in our hearts. Through Scripture, we encounter Christ, discover God's plan for our lives, and learn how to live as His disciples. The sacraments, especially the Eucharist and Reconciliation, are also powerful sources of grace that help bolster our faith. In the Eucharist, Christ nourishes us with His very presence. In Reconciliation, we experience His mercy and are restored when we fall. These sacraments help us remain steadfast in faith and continually draw us closer to God. The saints understood that a vibrant faith depends upon regular encounters with Christ through both His Word and His sacraments. God never intended His children to walk alone, when we trust Him during difficult times, our faith becomes a powerful witness to others. True faith is more than believing certain truths about God, it is allowing His whole truth to shape our lives. As we love others, forgive enemies, serve those in need, and seek holiness, our faith becomes visible in action. The Church teaches that faith must come from a "working charity," to produce the fruits of Christian love. The Catholic Faith is both a gift to receive and a treasure to cultivate.

Through prayer, Scripture, the sacraments, participation in the Church, and a life of charity, faith grows stronger and leads us ever closer to Christ. May we never forget the encouragement of St. Francis de Sales who said, "The measure of love is to love without measure." As our love for God grows, so too will our faith which helps us encourage the faith of those we love. Until the day we see Him face to face and believe no longer by faith, but by sight. Want to know more about growing in faith when you can't see faith? Your local parish is a great place to start looking with your heart. Stay tuned next week when we talk about what it means to "love your neighbor".
