DID YOU KNOW.....

The church says that anyone with a serious illness can receive the anointing of the sick? The Catechism states, "The anointing of the sick is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived" (CCC 1514). Through the ministry of the priest, it is Jesus who touches the sick to heal them from sin, and sometimes even from physical ailment. A person may also receive the anointing multiple times in their life's journey. So, the next time you're scheduled for a major surgery, or undergoing serious treatments for a serious condition, don't be afraid to reach out to your local priest and ask if the anointing of the sick is just what the Divine Doctor ordered. This should not be confused with receiving last rites or extreme unction, more to come on that next week.

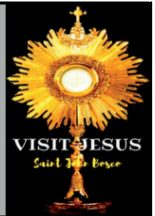
Getting Married?

Great news for those of you who have inquired about Adult Confirmation. The Archdiocese has scheduled September 25, at 10:00 a.m. for the first adult group this Fall. Location will be shared in July. If you have not yet registered this summer, please do so as soon as possible.

This summer we are beginning the journey to Easter Vigil, 2026.

This journey is for:

- anyone who would like to become a Catholic, or
- anyone who is unbaptized, 7 years of age to adult, or
- any adults or older children, who have been baptized Catholic but have not received First Communion or Confirmation.

The summer portion is called Inquiry,

- We encourage you to come to church and get acquainted with the Mass. You can sit and observe, or you can participate while watching those around you to know when to stand, sit, and kneel.
- The only thing you can't do is receive communion. If you do go forward with arms crossed over your chest, you will be told, "Receive our Lord Jesus Christ into your heart." It is not a blessing. It is a desire for Jesus. The blessing comes at the end of Mass, for everyone.
- After Mass, there will be someone present in the Narthex to answer questions that came to mind during Mass, or the Church in general.
