DID YOU KNOW.....

That the Church says the Anointing of the Sick and Last Rites or Extreme Unction, are not the same thing? Most of us usually think of asking for the anointing only when we are nearing death. However, like we discussed last week, we would be missing out on the opportunity for God to heal and help us at times when we are having surgery, dealing with a serious physical, mental, emotional or even spiritual affliction. However, if the sick or injured person is in the process of dying or near the point of death, the Apostolic blessing referred to as "Last Rites" or "Extreme Unction" would be administered by the priest at this point. Since the sacrament includes absolution via final confession and final reception of the Holy Eucharist, known as Viaticum, it is most important to call a priest as soon as the person is in danger, as they must freely communicate their own wishes. Giving your loved one the opportunity to heal their relationship with God is the best gift we can help them receive in this life as they prepare for the next. So, if you loved one is on hospice, seriously injured, or weakened because of old age, the time to call your local priest has already arrived. Stay tuned for next week's topic where we'll discuss what the Church says about marriage and divorce.

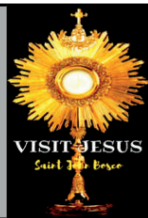

This summer we are beginning the journey to Easter Vigil, 2026.

This journey is for:

- anyone who would like to become a Catholic, or
- anyone who is unbaptized, 7 years of age to adult, or
- any adults or older children, who have been baptized Catholic but have not received First Communion or Confirmation.

The summer portion is called Inquiry,

- We encourage you to come to church and get acquainted with the Mass. You can sit and observe, or you can participate while watching those around you to know when to stand, sit, and kneel.
- The only thing you can't do is receive communion. If you do go forward with arms crossed over your chest, you will be told, "Receive our Lord Jesus Christ into your heart." It is not a blessing. It is a desire for Jesus. The blessing comes at the end of Mass, for everyone.
- After Mass, there will be someone present in the Narthex to answer questions that came to mind during Mass, or the Church in general.

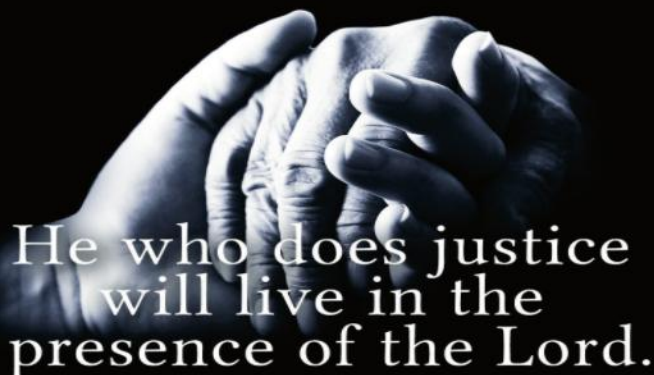
