

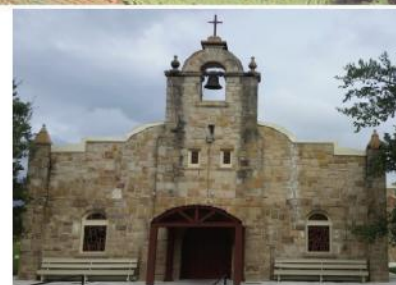

To serve as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion persons must:

- Be practicing Catholics, distinguished in their Christian life, faith, and morals;
- Be at least 17 years old, unless a pastor deems an earlier age is appropriate for an adolescent exhibiting a deep understanding, reverence, and devotion to the Eucharist;
- Have received the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist;
- Demonstrate a deep reverence for and devotion to the Holy Eucharist;
- Possess the requisite abilities and temperament to carry out their assigned duties.

DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know that the Church says, marriage in the Catholic Church is very important, but not just to make Grandma happy?

The reason the Church asks Catholics to marry in a church is to remind us that marriage is a sacrament. Sacraments are used to convey God's grace onto His children through the Church, via instituted ordained ministers. Marriage is not a mere contractual agreement between two parties, as would be the case in a union instituted by the Justice of the Peace, common law agreement, or someone else approved by the state government to officiate a contractual marriage. So, getting married in the Catholic Church isn't important just to make grandma happy. It's important because God desires to bless your marriage with the grace needed to overcome the challenges, the adversity and turmoil that the world will bring into our lives trying to separate your new family. The good thing, God's grace is way stronger than a contract written on paper. For more information on marriage in the Catholic Church contact your local parish office. Are you ready to baptize your child 6 and under?

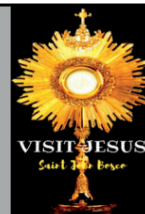
