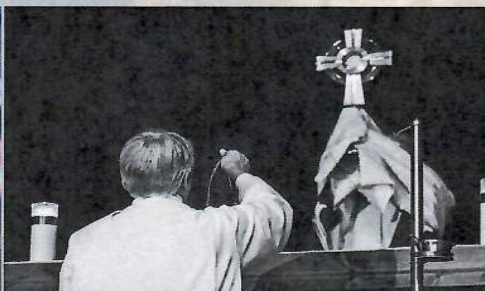

DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church says that someone is watching you while you sleep?

Don't panic, I'm not saying your neighbor is peeping through your window at night; you can call the cops for that. I'm talking about your guardian angel. Have you ever wondered if you really have a guardian angel watching over you? According to the Catholic Church, the answer is yes, absolutely. Every single person is given a guardian angel by God, from the very beginning of life all the way until death. This isn't just a nice idea or a comforting story; it's an official teaching. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says, "From its beginning until death, human life is surrounded by their watchful care and intercession... Beside each believer stands an angel as protector and shepherd leading him to life." (CCC 336) In other words, you're never truly alone. God has assigned a spiritual protector to walk with you through life. The belief in guardian angels didn't just appear out of thin air; it's rooted in Scripture. In Psalm 91, we hear, "He will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways." That's a pretty direct image of God sending angels to look after us. In Matthew 18:10, Jesus says something really striking, "Their angels always behold the face of my Father in heaven." Notice He says their angels, suggesting a personal relationship. So, this idea has been there from the beginning. Angels aren't like humans with bodies; they're purely spiritual beings. That means they don't have physical bodies as they were created by God before the physical world. They have superior intelligence and free will. Think of them as powerful, invisible companions whose entire purpose is to serve God, and help you get to heaven. Your guardian angel is not just standing around doing nothing. They protect you, especially from spiritual harm, even while you sleep. Don't worry, it's a good thing; remember, spiritual warfare doesn't stop just because we go to sleep. They guide you and help you recognize what is right. They inspire those good thoughts or nudges toward kindness and truth. They pray for you, bringing your needs before God. They guide and encourage, but your choices are still your own. It's important to understand that Catholics don't worship angels. Worship is for God alone; guardian angels simply help us to grow in our worship of the Creator. The Church celebrates the Feast of the Guardian Angels on October 2 each year. It's a reminder to thank God for their care and maybe pay a little more attention to their quiet guidance. At the end of the day, the Church's teaching is simple but powerful. You have a personal guardian angel with you every day of your life, and their mission is to protect, guide, and help you get to heaven. So, you're invited to be aware of them and ask for their help through prayers like, "Angel of God, my guardian dear..." It's a simple way of asking for help, protection, and guidance throughout the day. Many saints took this very seriously. St. Padre Pio, for example, often reminded people to stay close to their guardian angel and to be aware of their presence. It's a beautiful reminder that God's care for you is personal, constant, and closer than you might think. Want to know more about the guardian angel prayer? Your local parish is a good place to start looking. Stay tuned next week when we discuss what the Church says about drinking alcohol.
