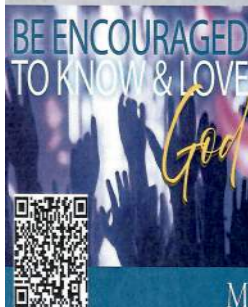

DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church says a person's worth has nothing to do with their bank account?

At the center of our faith is a beautiful and powerful truth, every human life matters. From the very first moment of conception until natural death, each person is created in God's image and loved by Him. That means our worth doesn't come from what we can do, how healthy we are, or what others think of us, it simply comes from being His. When we talk about difficult topics like abortion and euthanasia, it's easy to get caught up in debates and opinions. But at its core, this isn't just about laws or rights, it's about people. It's about protecting the most vulnerable and recognizing the sacredness of life, even when it's fragile or suffering. The Church teaches clearly that life is a gift only God can give and take away. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says that "human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception" (CCC 2270). This means that from the very moment a new human being is conceived, it possesses the full dignity and value that belongs to it as a creature made in God's image. According to Catholic doctrine, the right to life is the most fundamental of all human rights. Without this right, no other rights can exist. Because of that, ending a life, whether at its very beginning or at its end, is not the path we are called to take. Voluntary termination of pregnancy is considered a grave sin because it destroys innocent life that is completely dependent on the care and protection of others. In today's context, abortion is often defended in the name of personal autonomy and reproductive rights. Here arises an ethical question: Is it possible that one person's right over their body includes the right to end the life of another person? Catholic teaching holds that the fetus, though still developing, is a person with fundamental rights, and the decision to abort affects not only the mother but also a distinct, unique human life.

At the same time, the Church doesn't respond with condemnation, it responds with compassion. For anyone who has been touched by abortion or is facing end-of-life struggles, there is always mercy, healing, and hope. Suffering, especially at the end of life, is one of the hardest realities we face. Yet even in those moments, life still has deep meaning. We only need to look at the Jesus on the Cross to realize that in His weakest moment, He brought about His greatest achievement, the salvation of the world. We are called not to abandon those who suffer, but to walk with them. And with love, dignity, and care, help ease their pain without losing sight of the value of their life. As Christians, we are invited to be witnesses to this "Gospel of Life." That might look like supporting a mother in need, caring for the sick or elderly, or simply treating every person we encounter with respect and compassion. In the end, this is really about love. The kind of love that sees every life as precious and worth protecting. And in living that out, we become a light of hope in a world that needs to be reminded just how valuable every human life truly is. Are you suffering from the pain of a past abortion or need guidance with an "end of life" decision? Your local parish office is there to lend a hand. Stay tuned next week when we discuss what the Church says about life after death.

Congratulations on your engagement!

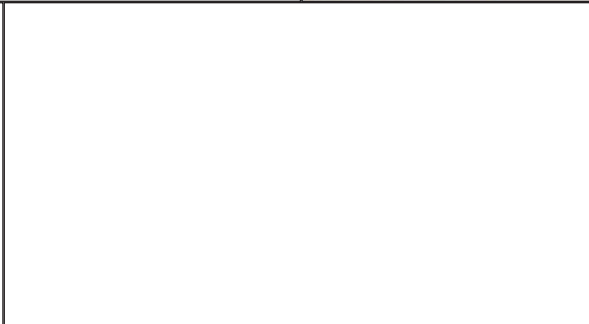
If you have found the love of your life and are now engaged, please contact the parish office with your names and all contact information to start your marriage preparation process, before scheduling your venues etc.
