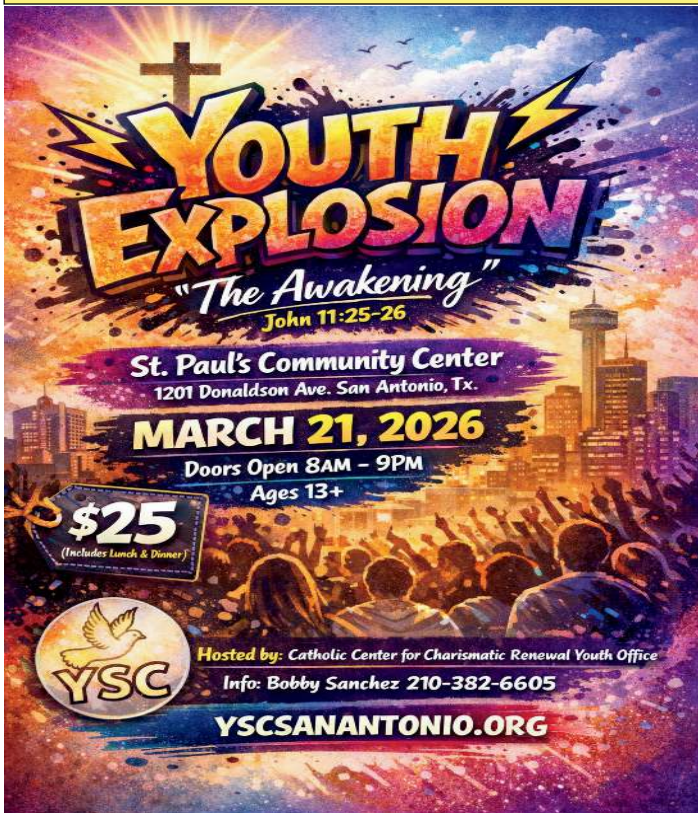

For many parents, the greatest obstacle to choosing a Catholic education has been affordability. Through the TEFA opportunity, families may now receive financial support that opens the doors of our Catholic schools to more children than ever before. This is not just a moment of policy—it is a moment of pastoral opportunity. You may hear this program referred to by two names. **"Education Savings Account" (ESA)** is the general term used nationwide to describe programs that allow families to use public education funds for approved educational expenses. **Texas Education Freedom Account (TEFA)** is the official name of Texas' ESA program. They refer to the same opportunity, with TEFA being the state-specific program serving Texas families.

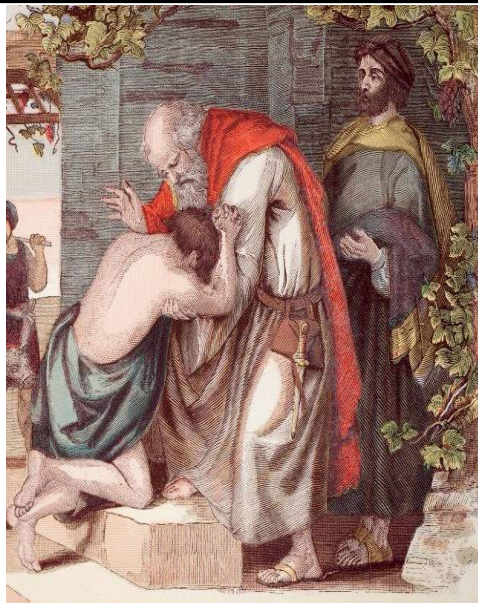

St. Andrew Renovation Project

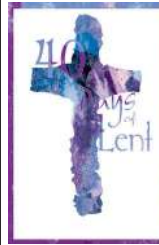

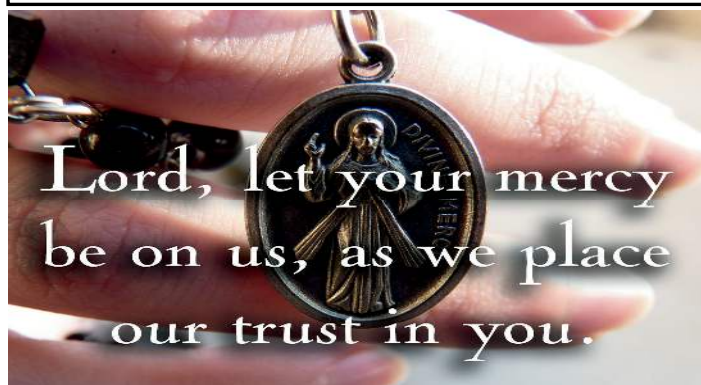


DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church says the more you run from the devil the harder he chases?

Don't worry he's not going to literally run after you with a pitchfork in hand. But rest assured once you start trying to right the wrongs in your life. Once you start moving away from him and start moving more towards God, the more devil is going to try and bring you back down. I mean, think about it, right after His baptism, Jesus doesn't kickoff His public ministry with a celebration. Instead, the Spirit leads Him into a lonely, harsh desert. "Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit... was led by the Spirit into the desert." (Luke 4:1) Hungry and alone, He faces harsh testing just like we experience in our everyday lives. The devil challenges Jesus to follow him instead of the Father by promising Him fortune, power, and fame. Yet in every temptation, Jesus answers with trust in the Father. In the desert, Jesus rewrites the stories of Adam and Israel; where they stumbled, He stands firm. And He doesn't do it for himself; he does it for us! Showing mankind what faithful trust looks like and giving us strength for our own battles. We all have our "desert days"; times when we feel empty, tempted, or unsure. Moments when shortcuts look appealing, when comfort seems more important than obedience, or when we want God to prove Himself on our terms. But Jesus shows us another way. Not through spectacular displays of power. Not through comfort or control. But through quiet, steady trust in God's Word. The same weapons Jesus used; prayer, Scripture, and reliance on the Father are the ones He places into our hands. Jesus' temptation reveals the way in which the Son of God is Messiah; through the disobedience death entered the world, now through perfect obedience, eternal life. This is why Christ vanquished the Tempter for us: "For we have not a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet without sinning" (Heb. 4:15). By the solemn forty days of Lent the Church unites herself each year to the mystery of Jesus in the desert [CCC 540]. As we walk through our own spiritual deserts, especially in seasons like Lent, we don't walk alone. Jesus has been there first and He stands beside us even now, walking with us through our own desert. Trusting in ourselves, following our own plan, is what brought us to the desert. Trusting in God and being obedient to His plan, is what takes us through the desert. Want to know more about allowing God to lead out of your own desert? Confession with your local priest is a good place to start. Stay tuned next week when we discuss the purpose of almsgiving in the Church.
