Is God Tugging at Your Heart?

As we enter into the Lenten Season, take this opportunity to observe and reflect. There are so many opportunities for you to explore the Catholic Faith during this special time.

Ash Wednesday starts us off, on our new Lenten Journey. And yes, every Lenten journey is brand new each year. Anyone, Catholic or non-Catholic, old or young, may receive ashes. (See services and Mass schedule on page 2.)

Stations of the Cross depicting Jesus's arrest and journey to the Cross is a pilgrimage of deepening faith we can experience every Friday of Lent. (See info on page 1.)

During the coming weeks we will follow and observe the journey of our catechumens (unbaptized) and candidates (baptized individuals who are professing their faith to the Catholic Church or baptized Catholics continuing their journey to complete their initiation sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. There next steps are as follows:

March 2 - Rite of Sending - Our Catechumen and Candidates are prepared by our parish to be received by the Archbishop or one of his auxiliary bishops at the **Rite of Election on March 8.**

March 16 - 2nd Sunday of Lent - The readings are focused toward our candidates in preparation for their first confession

The 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays of Lent are called the Scrutinies for the Catechumens, or "Elect" now that they have been received by the bishops. The readings of the Woman at the Well, the Man Born Blind, and the Raising of Lazarus, are in preparation for the their reception of baptism, confirmation, and first holy communion at the **Easter Vigil, April 19.**

As you observe and reflect upon your own spiritual journey during this Lenten Season, and discover that God is calling you to continuing conversion in receiving your initiating sacraments, or the desire to become Catholic, now is the time to begin your journey for the Easter Vigil of 2026.
