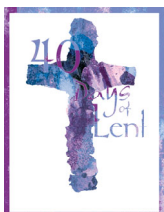

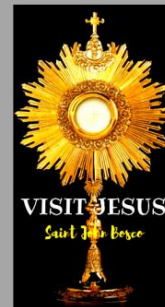
SVdP Lenten Giving

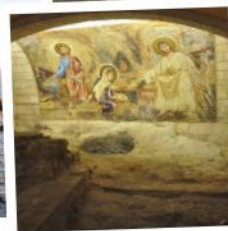

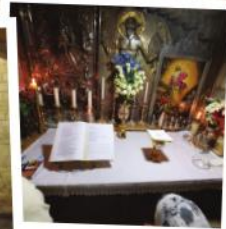
