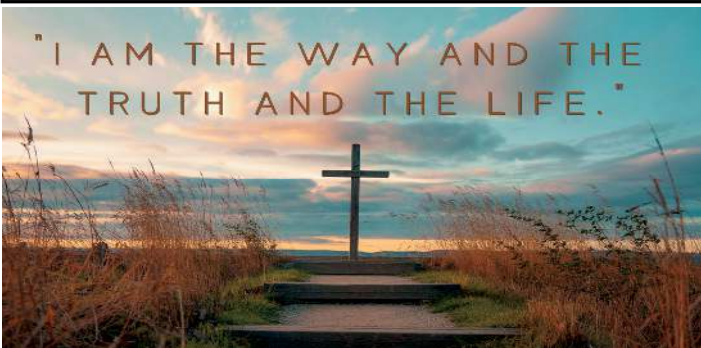

DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church says being meek and humble doesn't mean being weak?

One of the most misunderstood words in our Christian vocabulary might be meek. When we hear Jesus say, "Blessed are the meek," some of us quietly wonder; does that mean I'm supposed to be passive? A doormat? Afraid to speak up or stand firm? The answer, quite simply, is no. In the Christian life, meekness is not weakness. In fact, it's often the opposite. Meekness is strength under control. It is the quiet confidence of someone who knows who they are and Whose they are. A meek person doesn't need to dominate a conversation, prove a point at all costs, or win every argument. Instead, they choose patience over pride, gentleness over aggression, and trust over fear. Think about Jesus Himself. He was meek, but never weak. He calmed storms, He forgave sins, He challenged injustice, but He still carried the cross without complaint. True meekness allowed Jesus to love boldly, speak truthfully, and sacrifice completely. That same strength is what Christ offers to us. Humility works hand-in-hand with meekness. Humility doesn't mean thinking less of yourself, it means thinking of yourself "less often". It frees us from the exhausting need to defend our ego and opens space for God to work. When we are humble, we can admit mistakes, ask for help, and celebrate the gifts of others without comparison or jealousy. In daily life, meekness might look like, responding calmly instead of reacting angrily. Listening to understand rather than listening to win. Standing up for what is right without tearing others down. Trusting God's timing instead of forcing outcomes. Living this way isn't easy. It takes courage. It takes discipline. It takes faith. But here is the promise Jesus gives us, "The meek shall inherit the earth." Not because they are overlooked, but because they are anchored in God. This week, let us ask ourselves, where is God inviting me to choose gentleness over harshness? How can I lead with quiet strength rather than loud control? What might change if I trusted God enough to be meek? May we remember that meekness is not about shrinking back, it's about standing firm in love, standing firm in the Love of Christ. Want to know more about how to be meek and strong? Your parish office is a great place to start. Stay tuned next week when we discuss the different levels of sin.
