

Anyone interested in the OCIA – Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, be that adult baptism, becoming a Catholic, baptized Catholics continuing their conversion in receiving their initiating sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation. Your journey begins now for next year's Easter Vigil, 2026. 
