DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church doesn't want you to worry about sin?

Now before you cancel your confession appointment at your local parish, it's important to know that all sin negatively affects our relationship with God. Thus, we should have a healthy concern for avoiding sin but being overly worried that we might have sinned too much, is not what Jesus wants for us. Sin is anything that strains or breaks our relationship with God. We generally split sin into two main types, mortal sin, and venial sin. Mortal sins are serious actions that cut us off from God if committed knowingly and freely. To count as mortal sin, three things must be present, grave matter: serious wrongdoing, like murder, adultery, or stealing something valuable. Full knowledge: you know it's wrong. And lastly, deliberate consent: you freely choose it, nobody forced you. If left unconfessed, mortal sins endanger eternal life, but through the sacrament of Confession, God's grace restores us. Venial sins are less serious missteps that weaken but don't break our bond with God. However, if we keep piling them up, they can make us more vulnerable to mortal sins. The Church emphasizes that sin is not just about outward actions. It involves our intentions and the impact on others. Scrupulosity is when guilt and worry about sin get out of proportion and cause undue burden. Think of it as spiritual anxiety or a faith-based OCD. People struggling with scrupulosity might, constantly wonder if they've sinned over small or imagined faults. This can lead them to confess repeatedly without real need. Building up a well-formed and healthy conscience helps us discern real moral responsibilities and grow spiritually, while scrupulosity twists judgment, focusing on guilt instead of love or improvement. For those dealing with scrupulosity, guidance from a wise confessor or spiritual director is essential. Helpful strategies include having a regular Confession routine, without obsessively confessing trivial matters. Learning that intentions matter and imagined sins are not the same as deliberate wrongdoing. I find that a monthly confession keeps my heart and mind aligned while keeping lesser sins from piling up. Meditating on God's mercy and practicing patience and self-forgiveness are essential for growing our relationship with God and His people. After all, how can we love and forgive others if we don't start with ourselves? Sometimes, scrupulosity can lead to anxiety, and if the anxiety is severe, medical support can help address psychological aspects. Remember, sin is a real moral issue affecting our soul. Scrupulosity is excessive worry about sin and requires patience, guidance, and trust in God's mercy. Trusting that Jesus is the "Just Judge" will help us navigate guilt and fear without letting it overwhelm our spiritual growth and peace. The bottom line, God doesn't call us to worry about ways we can offend Him, He calls us His children. God is there to guide, love, and forgive; we just need to trust that His love is greater than our faults. Want to learn more ways to stop worrying and start trusting? Confession is a good place to start. Stay tuned next week when we discuss what it means to partake of the Holy Eucharist, worthily.
