DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church says that even though Jesus Ascended to the Father, He never left our side?

Ok, I'll admit, Jesus, at least the way He is depicted in artwork, is probably not going to knock on your door to ask if you need any help. But for Catholics, trusting that Jesus is only one part of the Trinity, allows us to receive His divine help through the Holy Spirit, whom Jesus sent to fill our hearts at Pentecost. Pentecost is one of the most important celebrations in the Church year. Observed 50 days after Easter, it commemorates the moment when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary. As described in Scripture (Acts 2:1-4), "the Holy Spirit came with the sound of a mighty wind and appeared as tongues of fire resting on each person." Filled with the Spirit, the Apostles were transformed; no longer afraid, they boldly began preaching the message of Jesus to people from many nations. Because of this, Pentecost is often called the "birthday of the Church." It marks the beginning of the Church's mission to spread the Gospel to the whole world. Pentecost is not just something that happened long ago, it is a living reality. The same Holy Spirit given to the Apostles continues to guide, strengthen, and inspire us today. Through the Holy Spirit we are given courage to live our faith. We are guided in truth and wisdom. We are called to share Christ's love with others. Originally, it was a Jewish feast tied to the harvest and connected to when God gave Moses the Law on Mount Sinai. At Sinai, God wrote His law on stone tablets, at Pentecost, God writes His law on people's hearts through the Holy Spirit. So, Pentecost isn't random, it's a fulfillment of something God had been building from the beginning. Think of God's life-giving presence in our creation story, "In the beginning, when God created the heavens and the earth and the earth was without form or shape, with darkness over the abyss and a mighty wind sweeping over the waters." (Genesis 1:1-2) God's Spirit in the wind was active then and is still active in the Church and our lives, calling us to grow in faith and to be witnesses of Christ in the world. "Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love." Even today, Pentecost is a big deal in the Church. You'll often see red colors (symbolizing fire and the Holy Spirit), and joyful readings and prayers focused on the Spirit. Because this is about new life and mission, not just remembering something that happened, the Holy Spirit is still actively stirring our hearts into action. What does it mean for us today? Pentecost isn't just history, it's personal. The same Holy Spirit given to the Apostles is given to us through the sacraments like baptism and confirmation. That means you're not on your own in your faith, you have guidance, strength, and direction. You're called to live with purpose and courage. The Holy Spirit helps people grow, make better choices, pray more deeply, and become who they were meant to be. The bottom line, God didn't just show up once and leave. He's still here, still active, still working through His Spirit for the benefit of all people. What started with wind and fire in Jerusalem continues today through ordinary people living out their faith in everyday life. Want to know more about how to live out your faith in the Spirit?
