DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church says not all prisons have bars?

When Jesus talked about caring for others, He didn't shy away from the hard stuff. He said plainly, *"I was in prison and you visited me."* That's where the corporal work of mercy "visit the imprisoned" comes from. And honestly, it can feel like one of the most uncomfortable ones to live out. Let's be real, most of us tend to think, *"If someone is in prison, they must have done something to deserve it."* And in many cases, that may be true, but Jesus invites us to look deeper. To see the person behind the crime, the brokenness, the pain, and to see the whole story. Jesus always nudges us toward mercy. That doesn't mean ignoring justice. It means remembering that every person, no matter what they've done, still has a soul in need of dignity and hope. If we're honest, while we may not be behind bars, all of us have fallen short in one way or another. It's the quiet realization, *"That could've been me, if not for God's grace", that should humble us. Prison isn't just punishment; it's often incredibly lonely, stressful, and even dangerous. Inmates deal with isolation, separation from loved ones, and a lot of uncertainty. They aren't just "cases" or "numbers." They're human beings who need encouragement, support, and prayer. And that's where this work of mercy comes in. We often think of prisons as physical places, but there are deeper forms of imprisonment all around us. Yes, there are those behind bars who long for mercy, compassion, and a reminder that they are still seen. But there are also quieter "prisons" that we can easily overlook. Think about our elderly loved ones in nursing homes. Many of them sit in rooms day after day, watching time pass, waiting for a visit that may not come. Their world has grown smaller, while ours keeps moving. Families get busy, routines take over, and before we know it, those who once cared for us begin to feel forgotten. Almost as if they are just waiting to die. And Jesus says, "go to them." To "visit the imprisoned" is really a call to presence. It's choosing to step into someone else's loneliness and remind them they still matter. Whether it's a prisoner, an elderly parent, or a forgotten relative, the mission is the same: bring dignity, connection, and love where there is isolation. Because at the heart of it, this work of mercy isn't just about where someone is; it's about who is being overlooked. At the end of the day, "visiting the imprisoned" is about more than physically showing up. It's about choosing mercy over judgment. Compassion over indifference. It's about recognizing Christ in people that are easier to forget or avoid. And maybe, in reaching out to them, we discover something unexpected, our own need for grace. Jesus is inviting us to see beyond bars and labels, to recognize the lonely, the forgotten, and the isolated. Remember whatever we do for the least of our brethren; we do for Him.
