

You will need to bring an updated baptism certificate with notations of completed sacraments.



The Archdiocese of San Antonio is unconditionally committed to the protection of children, youth, and vulnerable populations within our community. To ensure their protection from harm, it is mandatory that all adults who minister to children, youth, and vulnerable adults must receive Safe Environment Training every three years. The following are the three modules and those that are required to take each training:

## Safe Environment Training

Per the Code of Conduct, the Archdiocese of San Antonio requires a background check (renewed every three years) and three trainings:

### Sexual Harassment Training:

Required for clergy, candidates for ordination, employees, and all adult volunteers. Must be renewed every three years.

#### Protecting God's Children:

Required for clergy, candidates for ordination, employees, and adult volunteers who minister to children/youth. Ministries included: Catechists, Catechist aides, Religious Education support volunteers, and all Liturgical Ministers. Must be renewed every three years.

## Vulnerable Adults Training:

Required for clergy, candidates for ordination, employees, and adult volunteers who minister to adult vulnerable populations. Vulnerable adults are those 18 and older to whom you are ministering. Ministries included: All Liturgical Ministers (including homebound ministry), Knights of Columbus, Guadalupanas/os, St. Vincent de Paul, and ACTS, Must be renewed every three years.

The Archdiocese of San Antonio is currently using Virtus. To complete the training, go to <u>Virtu-</u><u>sOnline.org</u> to update your record. If you are new to Virtus, go to **VirtusOnline.org** and register as a firsttime user. Note the criteria above to determine the training modules you will receive. Modules **MUST** be completed within 30 days from August 13. Religious Education Catechists and support volunteers **MUST** comply before ministering to children, teens, or adults enrolled in Religious Education. There are NO EX-CEPTIONS to these guidelines. Please contact Debbie Shows, our Safe Environment Coordinator, for any questions or concerns. Together, we will continue to make St. Andrew and Sacred Heart a safe a nurturing place for ALL of God's people.

## ALL SOULS' DAY INTERCESSIONS

Our Mother Church teaches us to live the communion of saints by praying for each other, whether alive or deceased, in particular for the faithful departed who are in **purgatory**. At the same time, those who have already gone to heaven are praying and interceding for us who are still in pilgrimage here on earth.

As the Compendium of the Catechism teaches in number 195, the term *communion of* saints refers to: "the communion between holv persons (sancti); that is, between those who by grace are united to the dead and risen Christ. Some are pilgrims on the earth; others, having passed from this life, are undergoing purification and are helped also by our prayers. Others already enjoy the glory of God and intercede for us. All of these together form in Christ one family, the Church, to the praise and glory of the Trinity.

The existence of purgatory (Catholic dogma) has a Biblical basis. This is the reason why the Catholic Church encourages her faithful to pray for the dead. The Catechism of the Catholic Church n. 958 teaches:

Communion with the dead. "In full consciousness of this communion of the whole Mystical Body of Jesus Christ, the Church in its pilgrim members, from the very earliest days of the Christian religion, has honored with great respect the memory of the dead; and 'because it is a holy and a wholesome thought to pray for the dead that they may be loosed from their sins' she offers her suffrages for them."500 Our prayer for them is capable not only of helping them, but also of making their intercession for us effective.


