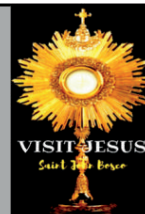

DID YOU KNOW.....

Did you know the Church says knowingly missing Sunday Mass or a Holy day of Obligation is a mortal sin?

It has long been Church law that choosing to miss a Sunday mass or a Holy Day of Obligation, without sufficient reason (like illness or the incapacity to get to Church) is a mortal sin. So, missing mass to get to the golf course early, or to get extra sleep after that late night at your nieces Quinceanera, doesn't exactly qualify as sufficient. The reason is simple, as creatures our first duty is to worship our Creator; remember the Ten Commandments? In addition, we are social creatures, thus, we should worship together at Mass as a community, and as the Since Jesus Christ is the Founder of the Church, and we are His followers, we are obligated to follow His commandments for our spiritual good. "Then he took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me." (Luke 22:19) So, yes, it is a mortal sin to miss Sunday Mass or a Holy Day knowingly, but what is a mortal sin in the first place? St. John says, "all wrongdoing is sin, but there is sin which is not mortal" just as "there is sin which is mortal" (1 John 5:16,17). One Body of Christ, which is the highest prayer of the Church. A mortal sin is one that, "destroys in us the charity without which eternal beatitude is not possible. Unrepented, it brings eternal death," as the Catechism of the Catholic Church puts it (CCC 1874). That is what makes it "mortal," or deadly: it cuts us off from God forever, unless it is "redeemed by repentance and God's forgiveness" (CCC 1861). Three ingredients are required in a mortal sin: grave matter, full knowledge, and deliberate consent. If any ingredient is missing, then no sin has taken place. Jesus tells us to give back one hour a week to attend mass, not for His good, but for ours. The fact that this is a command from God Himself, is what makes missing mass so gravely wrong. The good thing is that forgiveness and reconciliation are as close as your local parish priest. Please contact your parish office to find out more. Stay tuned next week when we discuss what makes up a venial sin, and what we should do to overcome it.

Thank you for registering your children in St. Andrew Catholic Church's religious formation program. This year we will be learning about our Catholic faith by exploring and learning to live the beliefs we profess. We have been blessed to have donors who have purchased a year's subscription of "Magnifikid!" for your children this year.

Each week your children will receive a *Magnifikid!* Booklet, to guide them through the Mass and Sunday readings. This booklet will also assist you in guiding your children through the daily activities found in the booklet each week. These activities will remind them of what they heard in the Sunday readings and how to live it during the week.
